Illinois Oil & Gas Industry Cleans up Oil Sites in Edwards County

The Illinois Petroleum Resources Board (IPRB) contracted with Earl's Tank Truck Service to remediate three old oil sites located in Edwards County, Illinois and restore the land for useful purposes.

Earl's Tank Truck Service was responsible for removing and properly disposing of several 210 barrel steel tanks, steel separators, steel substructures, and walkway, debris, piping, etc., from each site location. Also included was the disposal of tank liquids and bottom sediments in accordance with the Illinois Oil and Gas Act and all other applicable state and federal statutes.

The IPRB is aggressively remediating abandoned well sites in its environmental stewardship effort. It is one of the primary goals of the IPRB, which is voluntarily funded by oil and gas producers and royalty owners, to be environmentally responsible.
